Introduced by Senator McCormick - April 25, 1921 p. 595

Referred to Senate Committee on Expenditures in
the Executive Departments - April 25, 1921 p. 595

Reported in the Senate without amendments - April 25,
1921 p. 595

The Senate, as in Committee of the Whole, proceeded
to consider the bill, on motion of Senator McCormick,
and amended it - April 26, 1921 pp. 657-
662

The bill was reported back to the Senate as amended
in the Committee of the Whole, and the amendments were
concurrent in. Passed the Senate - April 26, 1921 p. 662

In the House:

H. Res. 74 - introduced by Mr. Good, for Rule for
special consideration of S. 1084, etc.-
April 29, 1921 p. 833

Reported, considered and amended (Campbell
amendment) - to provide that, in Committee of
the Whole House on the state of the Union, the
text of the bill H.R. 30 (Union Calendar No. 7)
be considered in lieu of the text of S. 1084 and
read under the 5 minute rule and considered as an
original bill in lieu of the text of said Senate
bill, and at the conclusion of such consideration
the Committee shall rise and report such Senate
bill to the House with such amendments as may
have been adopted in the Committee, whereupon the
previous question shall be considered as ordered
on the bill and any amendments thereto to final
passage without intervening motion, except one
motion to recommit. - May 3, 1921

In the House (Continued)

In the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union:

Under the above Rule, the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union considered the text of H.R. 30 - in lieu of the text of S. 1084 - and amended it. - May 3, 1921.

The Committee further considered and agreed to text of H.R. 30 as amended as a substitute for text of S. 1084; the Committee took up S. 1084 and struck out all after the enacting clause and inserted in lieu thereof the text of H.R. 30 as amended by the Committee. S. 1084 as amended by the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union referred back to the House with the recommendation that the amendment be agreed to - May 5, 1921

p. 1074-1091

The House considered and agreed to the amendment to S. 1084 recommended by the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union; motion to recommit rejected; and the bill as amended passed the House - May 5, 1921

p. 1091-1093

The House insisted upon its amendments and requested a conference. The House appointed conferees.

p. 1093

The Senate disagreed with House amendments and agreed to conference. The Senate appointed conferees.
