R E P O R T

Pursuant to section 302(b) of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974, the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources submits the report of its subdivision among subcommittees and programs of budget authority and outlays allocated to it in House Concurrent Resolution 91, the First Concurrent Resolution on the Budget for Fiscal Year 1984.

When agreed to by the Congress on June 23, 1983, H. Con. Res. 91 contained (a) revised spending ceilings for Fiscal Year 1983; and (b) spending targets for Fiscal Years 1984, 1985, and 1986. The associated budget authority and outlays for Fiscal Years 1983 and 1984 were allocated among the committees of the Senate. These budget authority and outlay allocations to each committee distinguish between exclusive direct spending jurisdiction (that directly provides budget authority and outlays) and entitlements (that are funded in annual appropriations acts).

This report subdivides those allocations of direct spending and entitlements in H. Con. Res. 91 to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources for Fiscal Years 1983 and 1984 among the subcommittees for the programs within the jurisdiction of the Committee.

**AMOUNTS OF DIRECT SPENDING AND ENTITLEMENTS ALLOCATED TO THE
COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NATURAL RESOURCES**

The joint explanatory statement accompanying the conference report on H. Con. Res. 91, the First Budget Resolution on the Budget for Fiscal Year 1984, contains the following allocations to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources:

Fiscal Year 1983

With respect to Fiscal Year 1983, H. Con. Res. 91 contains revised spending ceilings. The total Fiscal Year 1983 budget authori-

ty is \$987.989 billion (including \$883.360 billion in direct spending and \$104.629 billion in entitlements). Of this amount, \$1.263 billion is budget authority for Fiscal Year 1983 is allocated to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources; this allocation includes \$1.206 billion in direct spending and \$57 million in entitlements (See Table I).

With respect to these revised spending ceilings in H. Con. Res. 91, the total Fiscal Year 1983 outlays are \$905.956 billion, of which \$1.258 billion (including \$1.208 billion are in direct spending and \$50 million in entitlements) are allocated to the Committee.

Fiscal Year 1984

With respect to Fiscal Year 1984, H. Con. Res. 91 provides spending targets. The total Fiscal Year 1984 budget authority is \$1,028,090 billion (including \$928.725 billion in direct spending and \$99.365 billion in entitlements). Of this amount, \$1.733 billion in budget authority is allocated to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources; this allocation includes \$1.673 billion in direct spending and \$60 million in entitlements (See Table II).

With respect to these spending targets in H. Con. Res. 91, the total Fiscal Year 1984 outlays are \$948.836 billion, of which \$1.528 billion (including \$1.473 billion in direct spending and \$55 million in entitlements) is allocated to the Committee.

ALLOCATION BY SUBCOMMITTEE AND PROGRAM OF THE DIRECT SPENDING AND ENTITLEMENTS ALLOCATED TO COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NATURAL RESOURCES

In accordance with section 302(b) of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment and Control Act of 1974, the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources has distributed by subcommittee and program the Fiscal Year 1983 and 1984 directing spending and entitlement budget authority and outlays allocated to it under H. Con. Res. 91.

The Committee has distributed by subcommittee and program the revised spending ceilings for Fiscal Year 1983, as shown in Table III.

Similarly, the Committee has distributed by subcommittee and program the spending targets for Fiscal Year 1984, as shown in Table IV.
