S4517-21 (daily ed. Mar. 31, 1992), and the presiding officer referred it to the Budget Committee. *Id.* at S4501, S4517. When the Senate Budget Committee failed to act on a budget resolution by April 1, 1990, the Senate discharged both H. Con. Res. 287 and S. Con. Res. 104 from the Committee "[p]ursuant to section 300 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974, as amended," and placed them on the calendar. 138 CONG. REC. S4635 (daily ed. Apr. 1, 1992).
