

- § 1014(b)(1) (1) in the case of a special message transmitted under section 1012,<sup>1043</sup> the facts surrounding the proposed rescission or the reservation of budget authority<sup>1044</sup> (including the probable effects thereof); and
- § 1014(b)(2) (2) in the case of a special message transmitted under section 1013,<sup>1045</sup>
- § 1014(b)(2)(A) (A) the facts surrounding each proposed deferral of budget authority<sup>1046</sup> (including the probable effects thereof) and
- § 1014(b)(2)(B) (B) whether or not (or to what extent), in his judgment, such proposed deferral is in accordance with existing statutory authority.
- § 1014(c) (c) TRANSMISSION OF SUPPLEMENTARY MESSAGES. — If any information contained in a special message transmitted under section 1012<sup>1047</sup> or 1013<sup>1048</sup> is subsequently revised, the President shall transmit to both Houses of Congress and the Comptroller General a supplementary message stating and explaining such revision. Any such supplementary message shall be delivered, referred, and printed as provided in subsection (a).<sup>1049</sup> The Comptroller General shall promptly notify the House of Representatives and the Senate of any changes in
