## CONTINUING STUDY OF ADDITIONAL BUDGET REFORM PROPOSALS

§ 703(a) **SEC. 703. (a) The Committees on the Budget of the House of Representatives and the Senate shall study on a continuing basis proposals designed to improve and facilitate methods of congressional budget-making. The proposals to be studied shall include, but are not limited to, proposals for —**

§ 703(a)(1) **(1) improving the information base required for determining the effectiveness of new programs by such means as pilot testing, survey research, and other experimental and analytical techniques;**

§ 703(a)(2) **(2) improving analytical and systematic evaluation of the effectiveness of existing programs;**

§ 703(a)(3) **(3) establishing maximum and minimum time limitations for program authorization; and**

§ 703(a)(4) **(4) developing techniques of human resource accounting and other means of providing noneconomic as well as economic evaluation measures.**

§ 703(b) **(b) The Committee on the Budget of each House shall, from time to time, report to its House the results of the study**
