
GSE shall provide full and prompt access to the Secretary of the Treasury and the Director of the Congressional Budget Office to its books and records and other information requested by the Secretary of the Treasury or the Director of the Congressional Budget Office.

§ 13501(d)(2)

(2) In preparing the studies required by this section, the Secretary of the Treasury and the Director of the Congressional Budget Office may request information from, or the assistance of, any Federal department or agency authorized by law to supervise the activities of a GSE.¹⁸⁴⁰

§ 13501(e)

(e) CONFIDENTIALITY OF RELEVANT INFORMATION.¹⁸⁴¹

House bill

Section (d) provides the Treasury and the CBO full access to GSE books and records and other information as requested by the Secretary of the Treasury or the Director of the Congressional Budget Office. This subsection also allowed the Secretary of the Treasury and the Director of the Congressional Budget Office to request information from, or the assistance of, any Federal department or agency authorized by law to supervise the activities of a GSE.

Senate amendment

The Senate amendment contains essentially the same provision.

Conference report

The conference report adopts the House language.
