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# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 1625) to amend the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956 to include severe forms of trafficking in persons within the definition of transnational organized crime for purposes of the rewards program of the Department of State, and for other purposes; and providing for proceedings during the period from March 23, 2018, through April 9, 2018.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill  
3 (H.R. 1625) to amend the State Department Basic Au-  
4 thorities Act of 1956 to include severe forms of trafficking  
5 in persons within the definition of transnational organized  
6 crime for purposes of the rewards program of the Depart-  
7 ment of State, and for other purposes, with the Senate  
8 amendment thereto, and to consider in the House, without  
9 intervention of any point of order, a motion offered by the  
10 chair of the Committee on Appropriations or his designee  
11 that the House concur in the Senate amendment with an  
12 amendment consisting of the text of Rules Committee  
13 Print 115-66. The Senate amendment and the motion  
14 shall be considered as read. The motion shall be debatable  
15 for one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair  
16 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-  
17 priations. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
18 dered on the motion to its adoption without intervening  
19 motion.

20       SEC. 2. On any legislative day during the period from  
21 March 23, 2018, through April 9, 2018 —

22       (a) the Journal of the proceedings of the previous day  
23 shall be considered as approved; and

24       (b) the Chair may at any time declare the House ad-  
25 journed to meet at a date and time, within the limits of

1 clause 4, section 5, article I of the Constitution, to be an-  
2 nounced by the Chair in declaring the adjournment.

3       SEC. 3. The Speaker may appoint Members to per-  
4 form the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period  
5 addressed by section 2 of this resolution as though under  
6 clause 8(a) of rule I.

7       SEC. 4. Each day during the period addressed by sec-  
8 tion 2 of this resolution shall not constitute a calendar  
9 day for purposes of section 7 of the War Powers Resolu-  
10 tion (50 U.S.C. 1546).

11       SEC. 5. Each day during the period addressed by sec-  
12 tion 2 of this resolution shall not constitute a legislative  
13 day for purposes of clause 7 of rule XIII.

14       SEC. 6. The chair of the Committee on Appropria-  
15 tions may insert in the Congressional Record not later  
16 than March 23, 2018, such material as he may deem ex-  
17 planatory of the Senate amendment and the motion speci-  
18 fied in the first section of this resolution.

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
